### Allocation Summary for Nether Stowey CofE Primary School

As Nether Stowey CofE Primary School was oversubscribed, the published criteria has been applied to determine which pupils can be offered places.

31 preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) were received for Nether Stowey CofE Primary School which has a published Admission Number of 25. Places have been offered up to this limit.
